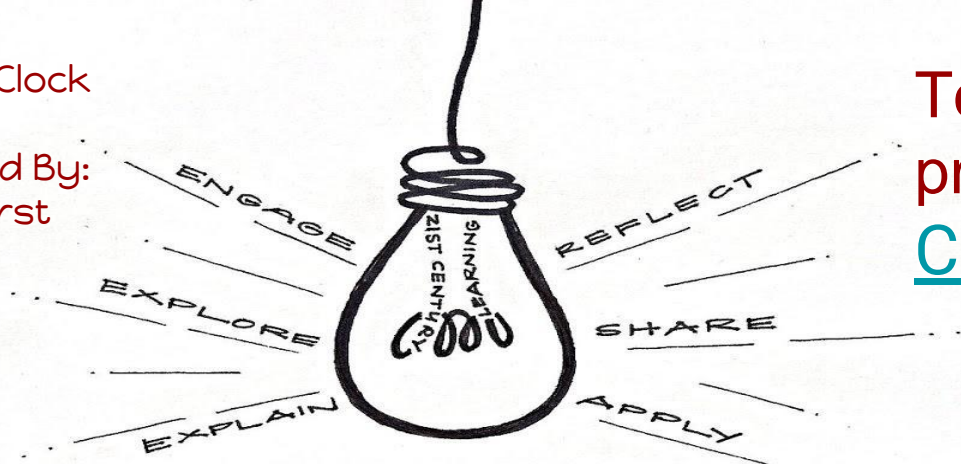

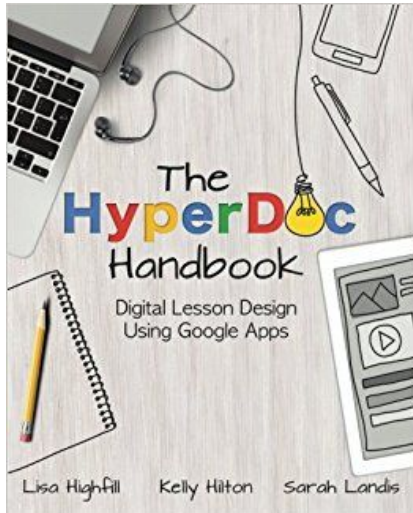

A hyperdoc begins with a way to engage your audience. You may choose a video, website, pictures, or survey to access prior knowledge and gain an understanding of what they already know.



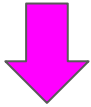

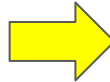

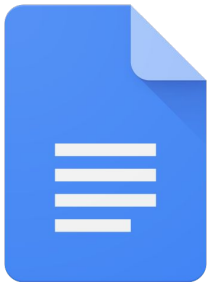
