When: November 1, 2018 OR November 15, 2018

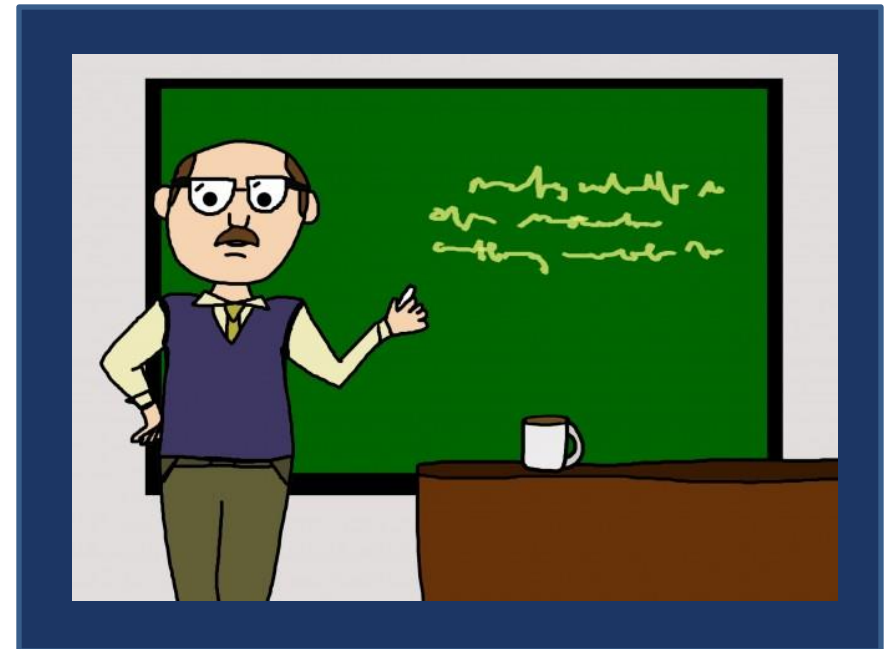

- If you hold an Associate's degree or higher from a regionally accredited institution or have completed 60 semester hours of college coursework, YOU QUALIFY to substitute teach.
- You must complete the required Short-Term Substitute Training AND Apply for the Short-Term Substitute License.
- You may apply for the Short-Term Substitute License prior to, or after completing this training.
- Official transcripts in a sealed envelope are required in order to apply for the license.
- The application fee for this license is \$25.00.
- The license is valid for substitute teaching in all grades PreK-12.
